The "100 Deadliest Days" is the period between Memorial Day and Labor Day when fatal teen crashes increase dramatically.

Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for US teens, and the period between Memorial Day and Labor Day is the deadliest for drivers ages 15-20.
